The first official CLMC® examination was held in 1981 under the name of Certified Lighting Maintenance Contractor. In 1987, the name was changed to Certified Lighting Management Consultant® (CLMC®) and continues to this day. Currently 125 CLMC®'s have achieved and maintained their designation.

- To raise the professional standards of the lighting management industry by giving special recognition to those individuals who, by passing suitable examination and fulfilling prescribed standards of performance and conduct, have demonstrated a high level of technical competence and knowledge to hold key positions in the industry.
